GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. It should be seen by all that proper and healthy atmosphere remains in school premises
- 2. If fees are not paid on due dates parents will have to pay fine.

 Regular delay and pending fees will lead to striking off the name of the child from school.
- 3. It is mandatory to pay all the fees in time.
- 4. Parents must inform in writing and take the necessary permission in case the child is unable to attend the school.
- 5. No parents should enter the classroom during the school hours, without the permission of the authority.
- 6. Parents should see to it that their child has complete kit of books, notebooks, stationery, uniform and other articles required for various school activities.
- 7. Any complaint about the school administration or teaching should be given in writing.
- 8. Parents who do not agree with the policies and decisions of the school authorities are free to withdraw their child from the school.
- 9. Parents are requested to encourage the child to participate in all the activities or programs conducted by the school.
- 10. Parents should visit the school whenever asked to.
- 11. Parents can meet the principal between 11am to and 12.30pm on saturday.

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. The School expects politeness, obedience and punctuality from all the students.
- 2. Students must wear proper uniform and attend school on every working day, ten minutes before the first bell in each shift.
- 3. A boy or a girl who comes to school without proper uniform must bring a note of excuse in hand book from his/her parents guardians, else he/she will be fined.
- 4. The students must look after all the thing he/she bring to the school. The school will not be responsible for the loss of any belongings of student. The parents should see to it that their children do not bring to school any valuable articles like gold ring, costly pen, wrist watch etc.
- 5. All pupils are expected to attend the school right on the first day after each vacation viz. Diwali and Summer.
- 6. Cost of any damage to the property of the school by the student would be borne by the respective parents.
- 7. Both the parents must attend the general meeting of the school.
- 8. Parents are requested to visit the school once in two months with prior appointment. It is obligatory to visit the school when called for special reason.
- 9. During the school hours, outdoor activities and picnics almost care is taken by the school authority for the safety and protection of the school children, but the school authority and the management will not be responsible for any mishap, natural calamity, fatal or accidental injury to the students.

- 10. The school management reserves the right to alter, to make any changes in the rules and regulations of the institute without any prior notice.
- 11. If a student remains absent for more than a month without intimation, his/her name will be struck off from the class register.
- 12. Dishonest practices, insolent unruly behavior will be severely dealt with.
- 13. The school follows the rules of promotion to a higher standard as prescribed by the education departments, Maharashtra State.
- 14. The result declared after annual examination is final and cannot be reconsidered.
- 15. Parents are requested to meet the teachers only on the last day of every month with prior appointment.
- 16. The boys are strictly forbidden to keep their hair long. Regular and proper haircuts in case of boys and proper hair do in case of girl are insisted upon by the school authorities.
- 17. The possession and use of mobiles in the school premises is strictly prohibited.
- 18. The parents / guardians are particularly expected to check the hand book of their children regularly. They should take due note of the reports and remarks of the head of the school and subject teachers, entered in suitable pages in the hand book, and sign in time so that the school authorities may come to know that the parents / guardians. are in touch with studies.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS

- Correct behavior is the expression of a fine character. hence keep a sense of self respect about your dress and behavior.
- If you find lost article, first try to find the rightful owner and hand it over to him/her. Otherwise deposit the article, found by you in the office.
