ADMISSIONS

All application for admission must be made on the prescribed form available from the school. Barring pre-primary classes, admissions to all other classes is based on performance in the entrance test and interview. No student will be admitted unless he/she produces a Transfer Certificate from his/her previous school. If He/She has not attended a school previously, he/she must produce a Birth Certificate. The date of birth filled in the admission form cannot be changed afterwards. School management's decision on admission shall be final.

WITHDRAWAL

The intended withdrawal of a student from the school must be communicated to the Principal in writing at least on calendar month (Thirty Days) in advance; otherwise on quarter's fees will be charged.

The School reserves the right to require the parents to withdraw their child if the progress in studies is unsatisfactory or attendance irregular or conduct harmful to other students or fees not paid in advance or if there are other reasons, which in the opinion of the school authorities, render continuance in the school undesirable. Honesty, cleanliness, good manners and loyalty are expected of each student. Anyone not conforming to school's ideals in these matters may be asked to leave. Immorality, grave, insubordination, contempt of the authority or wilful damage to property, are always reasons for dismissal.

SCHOOL FEES

Information regarding school fees can be had from the school office. Payment should be made through a crossed cheque in favour of "Green Valley School, Jaipur" or in cash to school office. The school fees are subject to change from time to time.

Parents/Guardians

Parent - Staff Meets are generally arranged after the Examinations. These must be compulsorily attended in the general interest of the child. The Progress Card is issued to the Parents/ Guardians only personally in such meets. The students must accompany their parents/ guardians to the Parent Staff Meet in proper school uniform.

Parents/ Guardians are expected to co-operate in enforcing regularity and discipline by seeing that the children prepare their lessons and do their home work. As the medium of instruction in this school is English, students should be helped to follow their work easily and intelligently by a certain amount of regular conversation in English at home.

Parents/ Guardians or other persons are not permitted to see the students or teacher during the school hours without the prior permission of the Principal. They will, however, not visit their wards or any teacher in the class / staff room under any circumstances.

Report immediately to school office about any change of address or telephone number etc. on the prescribed form.
