Registration / Eligibility & Admission

1. Children seeking admission to Nursery, L.K.G., U.K.G. and Std I should have attained the age of $2\frac{1}{2}$ +, $3\frac{1}{2}$ +, $4\frac{1}{2}$ + and $5\frac{1}{2}$ + respectively on the 1st April of the forthcoming academic session.
2. Prospectus and Registration forms for admission to the school can be obtained from the school office in the month of December-January on cash payment.
3. Admission are made subject to the condition of the vacancy.
4. The following documents are to be submitted along with the admission from :
 - a. Date of Birth certificates from Nagar Panchayat or equivalent competent authority.
 - b. School leaving certificate from previous institution (Not required for Nursery to Std II)
5. The date of birth once recorded in school record will not be changed in any condition.
