

#### ROOTS TO WINGS

#### \*Guidelines to Parents to keep their Children Healthy:

- All parents are required to impart health education to their children so that they maintain personal hygiene such as trimming of nails and being neat on a regular basis.
- 2. They exercise regularly.
- 3. Sleep for at least eight hours daily.
- Have a balanced diet, nutritionally rich in vitamins, proteins (vegetables, milk and fruits).
- Drink water which is either boiled or filtered and bring their own water bottles from home.
- Do not attend school if there is any infections disease such as Conjunctivitis, Dermatitis, Mumps, Scabies etc in their homes till the infection period is over.

#### \*School Disciplinary Code:

The school prides itself on its high standard of discipline and code of conduct. It expects all the students to conform to its code for personal hygiene, work-out, punctuality, manners, behavior, discipline and conduct; response to instructions; attitude to work etc. as laid down in the student diary. Any contradiction of this can lead to warning and punishment.

- 1. All the students should arrive at school at least 5 minutes before the start of the school.
- Students should be habitually clean and well dressed. The school uniform should be worn on all working days and for all the school functions. Students who are not in proper school uniform will not be allowed to enter their classrooms.
- Students are not allowed to enter the school campus without proper school uniform even for remedial of special classes during beyond school hours.
- 4. Non-Sikh boys should get their hair cut at regular intervals.
- 5. Students are not allowed to bring sharp instruments to school.
- 6. The school is not responsible for articles lost. Students are not allowed to bring articles like expensive watches or pens, tape recorders, cameras, calculators. I Pods, Cell Phones to school. Cell phones if brought in case of emergency must be handed over to the HM / VHM right at start of school.
- The school reserves the right to terminate the schooling at SMART EDGE SCHOOL of the student with unsatisfactory progress in studies or whose conduct is a bad precept for others.
- 8. Every day the child must bring in the school bag the following-
  - (i) School Diary
- (ii) Handkerchief
- (iii) Tiffin Box
- (iv) One pajama (from PG to Prep)
- (v) Water Bottle
- (vi) Anything else as and when informed.

## A HOME AWAY FROM HOME.

#### \*A student can be asked to leave the school for any of the following reasons

- 1. Irregular attendance or continuous absence for more than 6 days without taking leave in writing
- 2. Unsatisfactory effort or progress in studies or other areas.
- Non-payment of the school dues.
- Writing, scratching or engraving graffition desks, chairs and other surfaces.
- 5. Bunking classes / school.

#### \*School Uniform:

As long as a students on the school rolls, he/she must always come to school in the school uniform, even during practical, extra classes, examinations (inside or outside the school), organized tours and school functions.

#### \*Fees Regulations and Instructions:

- 1. Fees once paid will not be refunded.
- 2. Fees are collected in cash only from 8 am to 2 pm Monday to Saturday.
- 3. Fees are collected without late fee from 1st to 15th of each fees payment schedule.
- 4. No extra time is given for Sundays and Holidays falling during fees payment days.
- 5. After the 15th day of the month, a late fee is charged.
- From the 15th to the last day of the month, fees are to be deposited with a late fee of Rs. 20/- per day.
- If the last day of the month, the fees are not deposited, fees can be paid in the next month by paying Rs. 500/- as late fee.
- If fees are not deposited by 15th of the next month, kindly do not send your child to the school w.e.f. the 16th.

# BLOSSOM OF THE FUTURE

#### General guidelines for Parents & Guardians:

- Parents must ensure that their child comes in proper School Uniform daily.
- 2. Parents are not permitted to enter into the classrooms to meet their children or to seek unscheduled meetings with teachers during school hours.
- 3. In case of an emergency, parents must meet the HM / VHM and adopt a course of action in consultation with him / her.
- Once the child has come to the school, parents and guardians are not permitted to take him / her back during the school hours unless there is a major emergency, in such cases, permission of
- 5. Strangers are not allowed to meet students. Parents should not send anyone to pick their child from the school during working hours without written request and a telephonic message to the HM / VHM in order to ensure safety of their children.
- 6. Parents and guardians must inform the school immediately in case there is a change in their address / telephone number.
- 7. Children when sick should not be sent to school.
- 8. Students on their birthdays are allowed to come to the school in civil dress. They are advised not to distribute toffees or chocolates. Distribution of gifts (even pencil, eraser, and pen) in any form to staff is strictly prohibited. Teachers on their birthdays should not be presented any item other than a card (preferably self-made) or a flower.
- Parents and guardians must know that the school teachers are not allowed to give private tuitions.
- 10. We expect parents and guardians to be cordial and polite with the staff of the school even in the most taxing situations.
